



Re-Opening for P7 candidates of the Nursery & Primary Schools of St Francis Little Birds in Manny and Kamuli Childcare in Kamuli Trading Centre in Rakai District – Uganda on Monday, the 19th of October 2020

The Ministry of Education and Sports in Uganda has set strict conditions for the re-opening of schools for candidates (Primary 7, Secondary 4/O-level and Secondary 6/A-level):

- Training of teachers, candidates, and parents by official health workers
 - Training of the members of the Covid-19 Committee
- Recommended flu-related drugs in the First Aid Kit and a fence around the school compound
- Covid-19 gear such as temperature guns, foot-operating and common hand washing facilities, sanitizers, liquid soap, etc.

Inspectors of the Ministry have and still are inspecting schools in view of compliancy with the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) as set by the Ministry of Health.

St. Francis Little Birds in Manny & Kamuli Childcare in Kamuli, both financially supported for many years by sponsors in Germany and The Netherlands through Tusaidiane Uganda, have been inspected by the Ministry of Education and Sports and are allowed to re-open on Monday the 19th of October 2020.
